**15<sup>th</sup> August 2007** : Independence Day Programme was held in Patna College, Patna. 50 NSS volunteers of Patna Women's College participated in the march past.

**21<sup>st</sup> August 2007** : An Orientation Programme for NSS Volunteers was held with Principal, Dr. Sister Doris D'Souza A.C.. In her valuable message she encouraged the NSS volunteers to live up to the motto of NSS. She distributed work diaries among the senior volunteers.

**29<sup>th</sup> August 2007** : There was another orientation programme for NSS. Mr. Raman Sindhi, Director, Manas Manthan a Counsellor and Facilitator was the Guest Speaker. In his lecture he gave various tips on personality development.

**6<sup>th</sup> September 2007** : NSS Enrolment Ceremony was held in the College premises. The programme commenced with the address by the two programme officers Dr. Pushpa Sinha and Dr. Punam Kumari. The Principal, Dr. Sister

Doris D'Souza A.C. gave a motivational speech urging the volunteers to give their best for community welfare.

The Cadets of NCC, PWC unit have actively taken part in the camps, parades and other training activities of NCC.

**SPECIAL NATIONAL INTEGRATION CAMP (NIC), Ladakh**

w.e.f. 15<sup>th</sup> July 2007 to 06 August 2007

This was a national camp and a special NIC camp. For this camp, from Patna Women's College, cadet KRITI RANI was selected. The cadets were interviewed by CO and Group Commander. Those who passed the interview were eligible for the camp. The site of the camp was very cold but beautiful. 2 cadets from Patna group were selected.

**PRE -THAL SENA CAMP (CAT / TSC), Rajendra Nagar**

w.e.f. 05<sup>th</sup> August 2007 to 16<sup>th</sup> August 2007

This camp started on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2007 from PWC, 4 cadets attended this camp. The cadets', pre-TSC selection procedure was very tough. Cadets were selected on the basis of firing, map-reading, communication, health and hygiene. They had a written test before they were selected. Although the camp sight was Science College, Patna, the cadets went along Krishna Ghat for map-reading. They also went to Rajendra Nagar, every day for firing practices. The result of the Jamalpur pre-TSC was on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2007 and the result was published on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2007. Those selected from PWC were : Niva, Veena, Ritu, Khushboo for pre-TSC, Jamalpur.

PRE – TSC, Jamalpur

w.e.f. 31<sup>st</sup> August 2007 to 11<sup>th</sup> September 2007

For Inter group competition, there were cadets from Patna, Ranchi, Bhagalpur, Gaya and Muzaffarpur. From Patna a group of 20 cadets was selected. There were many competitions held on communication, Health and Hygiene, Firing, tent pitching, map – reading and line area non-banner competition in sand disaster, rangoli, poster making etc. The competition was known as Inter Battalion Competition. The Patna group cadets stood 2<sup>nd</sup> in the competition. A day prior to the last day of the camp, Firing was organized, Under Officer (UO) Niva. She anchored the cultural programme. On the last day, i.e. on 11<sup>th</sup> September, the cadets came to know the result of TSC – Delhi. From PWC UO Niva was

All India Sikkim Trekking Camp started on **19<sup>th</sup> October 2007**. The cadets of different States gathered at Sikkim. In this camp the cadets performed a cultural programme and did Trekking. From Jalpaigudi the cadets went to Shingtam. Priyanka of B.A. – I (History Hons.) Pratibha of I.A. and Preeti Bharti of B.A. – II attended the camp. The scene was lovely with plenty of greenery all around, however, the place was icy cold.

#### REPUBLIC DAY CAMP (RDC), **Delhi**

Started on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2007

This camp was considered to be the most prestigious and the toughest among all the other camps. It went on for a month. The selection was held first on battalion level, then State and finally National level. The Cadets got good exposure to prove their talents and learnt many things. **(e) FORD PATHWAYS PROGRAMME :  
FOUNDATION FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AND ACCESS (FAEA)**

This Foundation is committed to the idea of education devoted to founding a just, productive and cultural society. It focuses on the upliftment of the underprivileged, economically backward, meritorious students by providing them training on various life skills and scholarships. The aim and objectives for which the society is established are to undertake wide range of activities for the advantage of equity and excellence in higher education.

The Ford Pathways programme is meant only for the socially and economically disadvantaged but meritorious students. The uniqueness of Ford Pathways programme is that it is a sure and steady step in bringing the disadvantaged to the expectations and the demand of the level of the mainstream courses and society. In fact it builds a sense of equity and dignity. The FAEA trainees do well in their studies. Some are trying to speak English, some are able to speak well in English. All the FAEA trainees are computer literates, some of them do very well in the I.T. Skills. They are given special attention in the College, and there is a tremendous attitudinal and behavioural change by the time they complete the course. These trainees are ready to help any one who is in need and invariably direct them to the FAEA co-ordinator Sister Maria Reema A.C. of the Department of Psychology.

FAEA trainees learn how to make paper bags with different designs on it. They also learn different ways of making flowers and arranging them into a bouquet. They paint Diyas and decorate them artistically. About 500 Diyas were painted and presented to the teachers of the College on the occasion of the festival of Deepavali. They learn how to stitch garments, make soft toys, flower making, embroidery and crochet. Two embroidery and three ordinary sewing machines were purchased for the purpose. They also prepared a note book with all the different stitches. The information they receive in class will certainly help them to

be self-sufficient. Each group has separate teachers to teach and guide them depending on the free time of the students.

A book bank for the FAEA trainees is set up. The books are issued to FAEA trainees at the beginning of the academic year and they return the books at the end of the year. Books are also issued whenever they need them. The FAEA trainees who had successfully completed their written and viva-voce both in English and I.T. skills received their certificates. The FAEA trainees expressed their gratitude to Prof. V. R. Mehta and all those who have helped them in achieving the goals and objectives of Ford Pathways.

Ten needy but meritorious students were helped to open bank account and 09 were given a sum of Rs. 5,000/- towards the educational subsidy allotted for the same, under the special activities grant. A few FAEA trainees and a few economically disadvantaged students are given the opportunity to take admission for the **Certificate course in 'Human Rights and Values in Education'**, sponsored by UGC which is being looked after by the Department of Political Science of PWC.

Course Fee : Rs. 750.00; Duration : 01 year; Total credits : 15 (Theory : 10, Project report : 05). 01 credit = 15 hours.

The Self-Employment Skills classes began from **6<sup>th</sup> September 2007**. It was mainly organised for the B.A. final year FAEA Trainees. These classes were taken by Neeti Jhunjhunwala and Kumari Ratna.

**14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> September 2007** : FAEA Associate Colleges met at LSR, New Delhi. **Dr. Sister Doris D'Souza A.C.** and **Sister Maria Reema A.C.** attended the meeting. They had an enriching experience there. The articles prepared by PWC FAEA Trainees were gifted to the members of the Associate Colleges. There were highly appreciated.

On **28<sup>th</sup> September 2007** : Ubica and Priyanka held classes for students. These classes were attended in large numbers. It was open for all the 3 years.

**2<sup>nd</sup> October 2007** : A seminar on **Time Management** for all the FAEA students was held at PWC. **Mrigaya Sinha** – Clinical Psychologist was the resource person. 75 students benefited from this exercise.

B.A. – III and I.A. – II students had their examination in I.T. Skills and Remedial Teaching in English in the month of October. On 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> October, Ford Pathways programme was organized. Prof. Santosh Panda, a member of Ford Pathways visited and evaluated the FAEA programme on both the days. The

- General Staff Meetings, Departmental Staff Meetings, Orientation Programme for the teachers.
- A few Departments conduct post entrance tests, oral and written, to assess the aptitude of students.
- Students are encouraged to read novels and journals and are asked to write book reviews every fortnight.
- Leave notes are duly signed by the Heads of the Departments when students absent themselves.
- Regular circulars by the Principal to all the Departments give detailed information about the College functioning to the teachers and students, make the involvement and participation from all the stakeholders very constructive and effective.
- Visiting the bereaved family members of our staff and students.
- Teachers use learner-centred methods for teaching for the students to develop a holistic view of their subjects and also channel their interests beyond their text books and syllabi. For this purpose workshops, project work, exhibition, seminars, quizzes are organized in most of the Departments.
- Regular activities pertaining to Environment protection are held. “No to Polythene bags” drive is on in the College.
- Terminal examinations are held, revision classes and tutorial classes are undertaken, assignments are given and extra attention is paid to slow learners in order to reinforce the academic inputs given in classes.
- Almost all Departments have a Departmental Library.
- In many Departments career counselling is given in addition to Campus Recruitment Programme of the University.
- Emphasis is laid on inculcation of moral values in students. For this purpose several strategies are employed, for example, discussion on social, economic

and ethical issues, CD presentation of matters related to ethical and moral values, group activities on social issues such as human chain etc. are organized.

- Stress is laid on development of leadership qualities among students. Keeping this in mind duties and responsibilities are assigned to students in conducting several co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- In order to develop a cordial student-teacher relationship optimum interaction between students and teachers is encouraged. Most of the Departments conduct Mentor System.
- A great deal of stress is given to co-curricular activities. A zero period is marked on Thursdays (11:55 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.) during which an activity is organized every week. Students are encouraged to take part in University, District, State and National Level Contests and various Youth Festivals in which they regularly give excellent performances.
- There is transparency in admissions. The Principal meets the parents at the time of admission. Candidates are interviewed at the time of entry.
- Orientation is given to students periodically about College rules, Library rules, Terminal and Final Examination.
- Bulletin Board is a part of the Departmental Activity.
- First Aid facilities are available in the College.
- The outgoing batch (B.A. III) of the College is given a farewell combined with a prayer service.
- The Department of Philosophy holds Yoga classes for the students. They have regular Theory and Demonstration classes.
- Many of the Departments promote a sharing attitude by weekly display on different themes on values.
- They Departments of IMB has regular appraisal of teachers by regular feedback from students.
- The Department of Communicative English has a suggestion and grievance box.
- The Department of Physics has Physics Teaching through low cost and no cost experiments.

- The Department of Education has daily assembly programmes conducted by the trainees. They also have 'each one teach one' social education, literacy programme.


