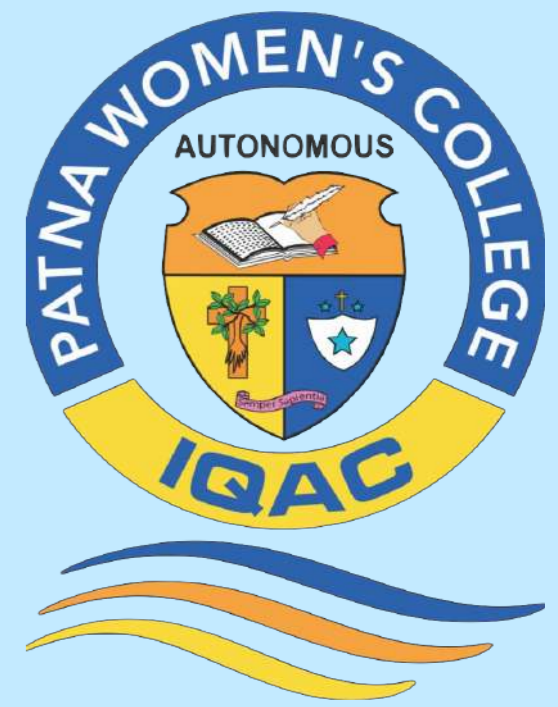

Thematic Background

Youth Migration is the key factor that affects social, economic, political and other aspects of governance in migrant, transit and destination regions. Migrant laborers are among the most vulnerable parts of the 'informal sector,' which make up 80 percent of India's workforce. The country's infrastructure is built on the backs of these workers.
