- Use of Official Email Address for all communications
- Secure Database for Exam Purposes
- Secure login portal for ERP Software
- Individual Login Credentials for Staff and Students

5. Functions of E-Governance and Information Technology Committee

- iv. Reviewing the IT maintenance mechanism and suggesting modifications if any.
- v. Recommending proposals for new software developments and purchases
- vi. Obtaining feedback on IT facilities.
- vii. Optimise the use of ICT facilities in the campus by implementing best strategies.
- viii. Equip and empower faculty and students through adequate training programs, technical know-how of the same in the campus on a periodical basis.
- ix. Make available the latest technologies in the campus and encourage the use of Open Source Softwares wherever required.

The E-Governance and Information Technology Policy of the college covers relevant ethical aspects of internet use on the campus and instructs all stakeholders on how the network facilities of the college may be used in accordance with the existing laws and regulations of the nation. The policy is regularly revised and the latest version is available on the college website.
